



Southeast Georgia Health System Distinguished Chair of Nursing and Health Sciences

The College of Coastal Georgia seeks applications and nominations for the position of Southeast Georgia Health System Distinguished Chair of Nursing and Health Sciences. The Chair is the academic leader of the 17-faculty member department, which is part of the School of Professional Education. In addition to being responsible for overall direction for a new pre-licensure baccalaureate program in nursing, an accelerated track, and a new RN to BSN program, the Chair supervises the associate degree programs in nursing, medical laboratory technology and radiologic sciences.

The Health Sciences program also is a partner with the Business and Science academic programs in developing new bachelor's degrees in Health Informatics and Biological Sciences. A new Health and Science Building, which will house the department's instructional and laboratory space, is under construction and scheduled for completion by December 2010.

The Chair will have a strong background in program design, faculty development and accreditation. The successful candidate must have a record of at least five years of progressive administrative experience, a collegial style, and excellent communication skills. The person chosen will have the ability to foster strong, collaborative partnerships with area hospitals, health organizations and the broader community. This is a 12-month, tenure-track position. The Chair must hold an earned doctorate, be eligible for licensure in Georgia, and possess a record of teaching and scholarship that warrants appointment at the rank of professor. The chair's position receives support and significant recognition through its endowment from and partnership with the Southeast Georgia Health System.
