- the ability to lead collaboratively in a manner that provides a supportive, responsive working and learning environment for faculty, staff and students
- a leadership style that enhances the relationship of the University with other educational institutions
- the ability to strategically position the University to achieve future success
- the ability and confidence to develop new relationships and nurture present ones that support the University's vision, mission, and goals
- the highest standards of personal and professional integrity and credibility
- ability to travel internationally, as need

ABOUT ST. JOHN INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY

Founded in 2007, SJIU is a registered as a for-profit company in New Hampshire, with its main administrative office in Concord, New Hampshire, and its campus in Vinovo/Torino, Italy, housed in the Della Rovere Castle, currently being renovated. All courses are taught in English, and the University's pedagogy is founded in the American tradition of a liberal arts education.

The University has four-year undergraduate and two-year graduate degree programs. In May 2008, the State of New Hampshire, Postsecondary Education Commission, approved to the University to offer the following degrees:

In 2009, the New Hampshire Legislature authorized the University to confer degrees upon its graduates, subject to the authority of the New Hampshire Postsecondary Education Commission.

THE UNIVERSITY'S MISSION

The mission of St. John International University is to offer liberal arts educational programs of the highest quality to a globally diverse student population. Through its undergraduate and graduate programs in the American tradition, St. John International University's objectives include promoting humanism, fostering respect for the fundamental rights of the individual, emphasizing research, and instilling awareness of one's physical and cultural surroundings. By integrating these objectives, graduates gain an environmental and cultural awareness, which prepares them to share with other members of society the responsibility that each has towards the natural and social worlds.

THE CAMPUS

The Vinovo Castle Campus is located 10 miles from Torino's city center. Originally built in 1510, the structure is of historical and cultural importance, and its restoration is underway. Highlights include original frescoes by Pinturicchio and original tera cotta reliefs in the courtyard. Once completely restored, the castle will have over 54,000 sq. ft dedicated to faculty, staff and student use, along with a 480-seat cinema, sports facilities and a park at its disposition. The entire castle campus is equipped with WI-FI.
