

Inviting Applications and Nominations for

Dean, Admission and Financial Aid

Schreiner University, a four-year liberal arts college affiliated by choice and covenant with the Presbyterian Church (USA), announces a nationwide search for a dean of Admission and Financial Aid. The review of applications will begin in mid-May with the goal to have the new dean in place by August 1, 2011.



The Opportunity

The Office of Admission and Financial Aid at Schreiner University is responsible for the recruitment of undergraduate students through diversified marketing, personal attention and excellence in all services provided to students and their families. The Admission and Financial Aid team includes 14 full-time, professional staff members and approximately 40 student staff members.

Reporting to the vice president for Enrollment and Student Services, the dean of Admission and Financial Aid provides strategic direction and leadership for the Admission and Financial Aid team in meeting enrollment objectives according to the mission and vision of the institution. Specific responsibilities include policy development, strategic planning and implementation of the recruitment plan, supervision, marketing, budget management and adherence to state and federal regulations.

Within a few years, the University expects its student population to grow beyond 1,200 with a minimum of 25 percent Hispanic students, at which time Schreiner will be considered a Hispanic-serving institution. Candidates with experience at Hispanic-serving institutions are encouraged to apply.

Qualifications

Candidates should possess at minimum a master's degree in business, higher education or a related field. In addition, qualified candidates will have demonstrated excellence and strong professional ethics in an admission and financial aid position within the past five years. Applicants with at least 10 years of related experience will be given greater consideration. The right candidate for this position will be committed to student success.

Founded in 1923, the once all-male institution has been coeducational since 1932. Schreiner is dedicated primarily to educating undergraduate students in the liberal arts, sciences, and professional disciplines, preparing them for entry into specific careers and graduate or professional programs.

Schreiner University awards undergraduate and graduate degrees: Master of Education, Master of Business Administration, Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of General

Studies, Bachelor of Science, and Associate of Arts. New at Schreiner is the University's Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree program. It is part of Schreiner's very successful life sciences signature program, which also includes pre-med and pre-dentistry. Classes for the BSN will begin in fall 2011 for students who have the required prerequisites.

Also available is a one-year certificate in vocational nursing as well as courses to prepare students for Teacher Certification, Graduate Teacher Certification and Principal Certification.

Students can choose from 27 majors, 7 pre-professional programs and 5 graduate programs. With a 13:1 student/faculty ratio, faculty members get to know their students and are mentors as well as educators.

The 175-acre campus is an easy walk from the center of town. A blend of colonial Georgian and modern architecture, the physical facilities include five residence halls, two apartment complexes, a library, student activity center, welcome center, an auditorium, an athletic complex, an ad-

ministration building, and four classroom buildings.

Athletics at Schreiner is an integral part of its whole person development program. A member of the American Southwest Conference, the Mountaineers compete in Division III of the National Collegiate Athletic Association. The university fields intercollegiate teams for men in baseball, basketball, cross-country, golf, soccer, and tennis, and for women in basketball, cross-country, golf, soccer, softball, tennis and volleyball.
